Ebola Virus Disease

The Ebola virus disease (EVD) epidemic has had devastating effects on West Africa and has been declared by the World Health Organization as a global concern. Over 20,000 people have been infected by the virus till date with more than 8000 reported deaths.

Countries like India with high population density and poor sanitation are vulnerable to such diseases. Metros like Bangalore are a hub of international travel and see a large number of foreign visitors for academic, professional and even healthcare purposes. This puts the city at risk for many diseases endemic to those regions such as influenza (H1N1) and other hemorrhagic fevers including EVD.

With no known drugs or vaccines against the Ebola virus, prevention and patient management remain the only options for minimizing the damage done by the epidemic. 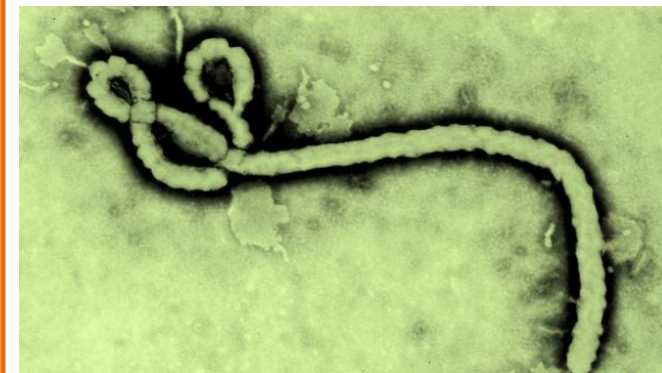
